

ARTISTIC SUMMARY

"Malaika" is the story of an elephant herd who, in their search for the waterholes, embark on the most fascinating adventures and reveal to us the secrets of the sacred Baobabs — those magnificent trees that grow upside down.

Like a gift fallen from the sky, the book "Malaika, la princesa" by Lizardo Carvajal came into our hands. Naturally, we immediately fell in love with Lizardo's work and proposed adapting it for the stage — and he said yes.

Once again, we are embracing the technique of shadow theatre combined with live acting, a creative approach that continually inspires and enriches the research and development of our artistic and theatrical projects.

Another innovative aspect of our project is the dramatic text and the use of oral storytelling within shadow theatre. We see dialogue not only as a dramatic tool but also as an aesthetic element, and we approach oral storytelling as a symbol — a form of expression that bridges gesture and emotion.

Stories, the words they weave, and children's theatre open endless doors to imagination — a place where wonder and creativity take flight. And through imagination, we learn to soar, even with our feet firmly on the ground.

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
























LIZARDO CARVAJAL




